There are two bronze plaques with the name Nicholas Lybarger at this cemetery. The plaque for this man is noted as "Sr" while the other is simply "Nicholas Lybarger" apparently signifying Nicholas Jr. The problem is that Nicholas Lybarger Jr is NOT buried in this cemetery. His body was buried at Erie, Pa where he resided upon his death in 1833.
