

plundered by the Indians & his goods plundered and destroyed among
 other things his said discharge was lost. That Declarant is now
 in his sixty sixth year that his constitution is feeble and general
 health extremely bad, that by reason of contracts made when
 times were better & lands higher than they now are & the great
 depreciation of property deponent has become reduced in his cir-
 cumstances his lands of value have principally been sold and his
 debts are not all paid. That deponent is the owner of the un-
 divided half of three hundred acres of third Wood land in Maple
 Township on the North of the state road, about one mile North
 of said road which deponent thinks are not worth more than one
 Dollar & one half per acre but which declarant is unable to sell
 & which he hath offered to his creditors at one Dollar per acre &
 they refused to accept of it at that price. That declarant hath
 no personal property whatever, & that he hath only one Debt which
 there is a distant probability of recovery and which declarant fears
 will not be recovered, it being contracted in 1794 and as yet in suits
 has been brought. That Deponent hath no family living with him, &
 he doth solemnly swear that he was a Resident Citizen of the
 State of Ohio on the 19th March 1818 having been a citizen of
 Crawford County since the year 1796 and that I have not since the
 said 19th March 1818, or before by gift sale or in any manner dis-
 posed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so
 to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act
 of Congress "Entitled" an act to provide for certain persons engaged
 in the land & naval service of the United States in the revolution
 my name passed on the 19th day of March 1818: And that I have
 not nor has any person in trust for me any property or security or
 securities contracts or Debts due to me nor have I any income other
 than what is contained in the schedule hereunto annexed and by me
 subscribed vizt a moiety of three hundred acres of Wood land
 or thereabouts worth \$ 200.00 or an uncertain claim ag^t Doctor
 Anderson amount not known.
