In open Court of Common Pleas personally appeared General Benjamin Birds of Bradford County being duly sworn, deposed and said, that he is well acquainted with the aforesaid James Anderson Esquire & that he knows that said James Anderson Esquire was a soldier in Captain Brown's company as stated in his declaration that he met said Colonel Piper with his Regiment of Riflemen being a part of the State of Pennsylvania in the Command of Colonel Miller in four miles west of Amboy in New Jersey and that Deponent was in the Battle of Long Island & knows that Colonel Piper & most of his Regiment were captured at said Battle & that Captains Brown & Deans & most of his company were taken in said Battle and that he believes the facts set forth in said Declaration & Statement as to his Revolutionary services are true
