Be it remembered that on the
ninth day of April in the year our Lords on
thousand eight hundred and eighteen before
Jonathan Walker Esquire President of the Court
of Common Pleas of Bedford County and John
Dickey and Abraham Martin Esquires
Associates Judges of the said Court now holden
in and for the County of Bedford and Common-
wealth of Pennsylvania, came into Court
Joseph Cooper of the County of Bedford and a
resident Citizen of the United States and being
duly sworn according to Law doth declare
and say that he entered into the Army of
the United Colonies, by entering as a Soldier
on the twenty third day of August one
thousand seven hundred and seventy six
with Captain Andrew Maun of Bedford
County Pennsylvania of the 8th Regiment of
The Line of Pennsylvania Line which said
Regiment was then commanded by Col. McCoy
and composed part of General Anthony
Waynes Brigade in which Regiment ^{the} deponent
served as a Soldier three years two months and
