On the fifth day of August
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
dred and nineteen before me the subscribed an
Associated Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, of
Quincy Tipton Es. of the County of Bedford, Pa. personally
appeared William Davis aged fifty two years a
Citizen of the United States and now a Resident
Citizen of the County of Bedford in the State of
Pennsylvania who being duly sworn, doth on his oath
make the following declaration in order to obtain the
provisions made by the late Act of Congress entitled
"An Act to provide for certain persons engaged in
the land and naval service of the United States in
the Revolutionary War" That he is the said William
Davis who enlisted about the first of March 1777
in Frederick's Camp in the State of Maryland as a pri-
vate soldier in the Company of Captain Still of the 7th
Regiment of the Maryland line. That he the said
William Davis continued to serve according to the terms
of his enlistment in the Revolutionary Army upon the
Continental establishment against the Common enemy
until the first of March 1780 when he was discha-
ged from the Service in ^{Northtown} ~~Northtown~~ in the State
of New Jersey, which said discharge has been lost
That in the course of said Service the Deponent
was at the Battles of Brandywine, Red Bank and
Mormouth. That this Deponent is now in de-
duced circumstances, and stands in need of the
assistance of his Country for Support; and
