ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Frederick Hill is claimed to have been a British soldier who deserted and joined the Patriots under General Gates on 14 June 1777. Note that another man by the name of Frederick Hill is claimed to be buried in the Old Presbyterian Cemetery at Bedford Borough. A biography written by Mary Lou Cook for the Find-A-Grave entry claims that he served under Captain Andrew Mann, but the company under Captain Mann, in which Frederick Hill's name appears was recruited in 1776.
