Harry K. Woodcock claimed that John Miller served as a Captain in the 6th Pennsylvania Regiment. The reference in the 5th Series, Volume III, Page 182 stated that the John Miller who served in the 6th Regiment died in Lancaster County in 1818. None of the eleven pensioners resided in Bedford County. John and his brothers, Elias and Peter were included on a list of soldiers who received depreciation pay from service in Bedford County.
