detail his first enlistment and service

wise it would have been so stated
in his said application - That he the
deponent will be sixty five years of age
on the 11th day of next May, if he shall live so
long - That he is now very infirm &
in reduced circumstances in life, and
stands in need of the assistance of his
Country for support and that he hath no
pension allowed heretofore by the
Government of the United States -
