Reference is made to your letter in which you request the Revolutionary War records of James and John Boyle, both of Pennsylvania.

The data which follow were obtained from the papers on file in pension claims, based upon their services in the War of the Revolution.

**James Boyle-S.40019**

The date and place of birth of James Boyle are not shown in the claim, nor are the names of his parents stated.

He enlisted at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in July, 1776, served as a private in Captain Carson's company, Colonel Mackey's ~~company~~'s Eighth Pennsylvania Regiment, was captured at the battle of Bound Brook and held sixteen months in the Sugar House in New York City.

James Boyle was allowed pension on his application executed, May 8, 1818, then aged about sixty-four years and living in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He died June 28, 1825.
