

Pennsylvania; moved from there to York County, Pennsylvania, near Abbottstown; thence to Marsh Creek, in said York County; thence to Huntington County, Pennsylvania.

James Clark was allowed pension on his application executed November 16, 1833, at which time he was aged seventy-six or seventy-seven years and resided in Huntington County, Pennsylvania.

There are no data as to family.
