Before me the subscriber one of the associate Judges  
of the Court of Common Pleas & Grand for the County  
aforesaid. Personally came James Gray who being sworn  
as Law Serjeant deponeth and saith that he embarked about  
the beginning of the year one thousand seven hundred and  
twenty six under Capt Joseph Medham in the Town  
of Wilmington in the State of Delaware for one year  
and from thence he marched to Dover from thence to  
Lewis Down under the command of Col John Hargrett  
thence to Philadelphia thence to the City of New York  
in the month of August 1776 we joined Lord  
Sterlings ~~Battle~~ on the Twentieth sixth of  
August the same year we passed over to Long  
Island and on the 27 same month he debanded  
was in the Battle at that place, and made  
his escape by passing over a Mill Pond with  
others, and got to a small Battery belonging to the  
British under cover of Fort Putnam beyond  
was on the Last Guard that remained on said  
Island from thence we went to our old Quarters  
about two miles above York City Twentieth  
Eight day of October 1776 Depoent was at the  
Battle of the Clouds Plains from thence he went  
to Brunswick New Jersey there he was attacked
