On the seventeenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, Personally appeared in open Court of Common Pleas of Huntingdon County before the Honorable Charles Houston Esq. President and David Stewart and Joseph McBune Esquires Associate Judges of the said Court being a Court of Records for the same district John Holliday aged seventy one years Resident of Pleasanton Township in the said County of Huntingdon in the said district who being duly sworn according to Law doth declare on his oath that he served in the Revolutionary war as follows Viz that he was a second lieutenant in Colonel William Thompsons Regiment in the Pennsylvania line in the year 1775 and his Commission bears date 25th June 1775 that he marched to Boston and was afterwards ordered to New York and was at the Battle of Brantwines and also at the Battle of Brandywine and at the Pass that he lay at the Valley Forge with the army in the winter and was at the Battle of Germantown and then being Captain he resigned and returned home to Bedford County Pennsylvania that his original declaration is dated the twenty first day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighteen and that the number of his Certificate as a Pensioner is N^o 11900 and I do solemnly swear that I was a Resident citizen of the United States on the eighteenth day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with an intent thereby to diminish or so as to bring myself within the Provisions of an act of Congress entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the Land and Naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War passed on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not any property or securities contracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed
