Daniel Bloom of McConnellsburg in the county of Bedford
in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Blacksmith upon
oath makes the following Declaration

That the said Daniel Bloom in the month of June A.D. 1776

Enlisted as a noncommissioned Officer for the term of one year
under Capt. John Brisbane's company of Foot in Col. Arthur St.

Clairs Regt of the Pennsylvania Line that the Declarant

Truthfully serves the whole of said term in said company

and in the month of May A.D. 1777 Honourably Discharged

the Declarant received Written Certificates of his Discharge

and that he has lost the same by time and accident.

That the Declarant is better than 70 years old Infirm and

from his reduced Circumstances in life is now in need

of assistance from his country for support and that he never

has received any assistance from his country.

Personley Appears before me one of

the associate Judges in and for said county Charles Zipper and

being duly sworn Deposition and oath that he knew the

above Applicant Daniel Bloom when in service in the

Winter of 1777 that he was in the service Regt. Commanded

by Col. Arthur St. Clair in the company commanded by

Capt. John Brisbane and that he was in the Battle of the

Three Rivers Moorhead and subscribed this 20 Day of Apr.
