WIDOW'S PENSION.

I certify that in conformity with the act of February 2d, 1848,
Elizabeth Cusley,
widow of *George Cusley,*
who was a *Private Captain* in the revolutionary war,
is inscribed on the pension list at the rate of *fifty three*
dollars and *thirty three* cents per annum, commencing on the
4th of March, 1848, and continuing for life, unless she should again
marry; in which case the Pension is not payable after the time of such
marriage.
