

That after this term of service, deponent ~~was~~ volunteered under the command of Mr. Elery & Buchanan - and proceeded over the Allegheny Mountains - from thence he went to a place called "Short Sleeping place" over the Allegheny Mountains, he was then marched about twelve miles further to a creek, which deponent does not now recollect the name of - from thence he returned home - he served on this term two weeks - he cannot recollect particularly as to the year this service was performed in but knows it was after the one in 1778 -
