 29th June last, that he has no Trade, but sometimes works
 at daily Labor, but that owing to his advanced age
 is unable to obtain a livelihood thereby for himself &
 Family which consists of a wife Jane sixty eight
 Years of age, who has been sickly for five Years, and
 is very infirm, & two Daughters Jane & Catherine
 one aged Twenty six Years, the other twenty two years
 that one has two Children & that it takes her services to
 support them & that the other is affected with the
 Phthisic & is very frequently unable to labor, or contribute
 anything to their support
