Pleas holden this day / Court the 19th day of August 1820 at
Huntingdon before the Honourable Charles Houston Esquire
his Associates David Stewart and Joseph McBurne Esquires
Judges of the said County being a Court of Record Personally
appeared in open Court Joseph Gaddis who being duly sworn
deposes and saith and on his oath aforesaid doth declare
that he enlisted as a soldier in the Revolutionary war for
the term of one year and nine months in a company
commanded by Captain Green afterwards commanded
by Captain Alexander 5th Regiment in the Pennsylvania
line commanded by Colonel Swin as set forth in his ori-
ginal declaration the date of which he doth not now re-
collect but believes it was some time in May, 1818 which
said declaration was forwarded to the war department
and on which a Pension Certificate issued to the said
Joseph Gaddis dated the nineteenth day of April 1820 signed
W. B. Calhoun Secretary of the war which Certificate is
numbered 16,733 and is now in the possession of the De-
clarant which in pursuance of the Act of Congress of
the 20th of May, 1820 makes the following declaration
on oath (to wit) I Joseph Gaddis do swear that I
was a Resident Citizen of the United States on the 18th day
of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift
sale or in any other manner disposed of my property
or any part thereof with an intent thereby to diminish
it as to bring myself within the Provisions of an act of
Congress entitled an act to provide for certain persons
engaged in the Land and Naval Service of the United
States in the Revolutionary war passed on the 18th day of
March 1818 and that I have not nor has any person
or persons in trust for me any property or securities
contracts or debts due me nor have I any income other
than which is contained in the schedule hereunto annexed
and by me subscribed the said declarant also states that
he is seventy five years old on the 17th day of March
