

Commission issued dated 10<sup>th</sup> May 1780, which he has preserved & herewith submits - served the three years which was the term of the commission - Colonel Crawford of Lancaster County Commandant - Abraham Henry (brother to applicant) was a major - served the term in Lancaster and other places to which we were ordered and occasionally in New York - was commissioned Captain a third time and served till the end of the war. In my company I remember the following persons who served three brothers by name of Mepers - two brothers by name of Hare & two Hices and also two brothers by name of Williams. The document bears evidence the person in the Commission before referred to - James Watson who is also an applicant for the benefit of the Law, the last time he was put was a member of my company. John Waggoner a revolutionary soldier now living in this county was in the same battalions. He here by relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the Books or rolls of any state -

2. Have you any record of your age: yes, where is it? No. Have no record at this time. Had my age recorded in a family bible brought from Ireland and which my sister took with her when she removed from Lancaster County. She is dead & I don't know what has become of the record.
3. Where were you living when called into service. where have you lived since the revolutionary war and where do you now live? Mrs. Linn in Chester County when I first volunteered. then in Lancaster till a number of years after the end of the war, when I removed to Kichass: Killas Bally Miffkin County where I lived four years, when I removed to my present place of residence in Barren Township Huntingdon County where I have resided for the last thirty three years.
