Questions by the Court

- 1- Where and in what year were you born?
 I can recollect in what year I was born but I will be sworn by the 26th February next
- 2- Have you any record of your age; and if so when is it?
 I have no record of my age - It is recorded I put containing in a family Bible which was kept by my father I have not the Bible but think it is in Centre County Penn^a
- 3- Where were you living when called into service; where have you lived since the revolutionary war, and where do you now live?
 I was living in Huntingdon County in the state of New Jersey when first called into service - and moved from Jersey to Carlisle in Cumberland County Penn^a - moved from thence to Susquehanna valley in what is now Summit County - about 2 years since moved to Henderson Sp. Huntingdon County having lived occasionally here for the last 20 years
- 4- How were you called into service, were you drafted, did you volunteer or were you a substitute? If a substitute for whom first service I was drafted - and afterwards enlisted I was not a substitute
