Huntingdon County At a Court of Common Pleas
held at Huntingdon in & for said County before the
Honourable Charles Huston President & his Associates Judges
of said Court Court of August Term 1826 Personally app-
eared in open Court said Court being as Court of Records
in & for said County & district aforesaid John Irvine
of said County aged seventy years & upwards who being duly
sworn according to law doth on his oath declare that he
served in the Revolutionary against the Common Enemy as
follows to wit that in the year 1775 he enlisted with Col.
Anthony Wayne & served one year & then enlisted for three
years in the Regiment commanded by Colonel Francis
Johnson & served for said time all which is set forth in his
original Declaration the precise date of which Declarant
doth not now remember on which a Pension Certificate issued
to him the said John Irvine signed J. C. Calhoun Secretary
of War dated the ninth day of October 1818 numbered 3,998 & now
in possession of Declarant & in order to entitle him to the Provi-
sions of the Act of Congress passed the 20th May 1820 the said
John Irvine doth make on oath as aforesaid the following
declaration to wit I John Irvine do swear that I was a resident
Citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 & that
I have not since that time by gift sale or in any manner
disposed of my property or any part thereof with the intent thereby
to diminish it as to bring myself within the Provisions of an Act
of Congress entitled an Act to provide for certain persons engaged
in the land and naval service of the United States in the
Revolutionary war passed on the 18th day of March 1818 and that
I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property
or securities contracts or debts due to me nor have I ^{any} other ^{than}
any property contained in the schedule hereunto annexed
and by me subscribed and that declarant never
had any family that his infirmities and age dis-
qualify him from using his former exertion and
industry in earning his subsistence the only income
