His Officers to this tour were Captain John Beason 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant John McLeod William Crawford was Colonel. Daniel Williamson was Lieutenant Colonel. Daniel Light was Major -

In the year 1795 I moved from there to Stone Valley, in Berks County, Pennsylvania, where I now reside, and have ever since resided.
