His pension application notes that he served under Captains Edward Stewart and John Beeson, but neither of them appear as Captains in the published Pennsylvania Archives. The tombstone, which is a relatively new one includes the prefix "Col." suggesting that William was a Colonel. There exists no evidence that he ever served in that capacity, nor does he state so in his pension application.
