me the subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace in
and for the County of Huntingdon personally came
John Downs an old Revolutionary soldier and being
sworn according to law deposed and saith that he
knows William Newil well and that he frequently
saw said Newil when he belonged to the Delaware
Blues in the service of the United States when they
happened to be both on guard together on sentry several
times and that he saw said Newil in the City of
Philadelphia and that he saw said Newil the next
day after the battle of Brice town and said Newil
was still a regular soldier in the service of the
United States in the Delaware line and that Newil
was still considered a good soldier and further
saith not

sworn and subscribed
before me the day and
date aforesaid
