 Huston Esquire President and David Stewart and
 Joseph McBune Esquires his associates Judges of the Court
 of Common Pleas for Huntingdon County in the Common-
 wealth of Pennsylvania said Court being a Court of
 Record) Peter O'K who being a Resident in said County
 aged fifty five years and being first duly sworn according
 to Law doth declare on his oath that he served in the
 Revolutionary war as follows that in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and eighty two he enlisted
 in Captain Vanhairs Company for during the war
 at the end of which Period he was Honourably discharged
 that his original declaration is dated the seventeenth
 day of June A D one thousand eight hundred and
 nineteen and the number of his Pension Certificate is
 12,555 and I do solemnly swear that I was a Resident
 Citizen of the United States on the eighteenth day of March
 A D one thousand eight hundred and eighteen and that I
 have not since that time by gift sales or in any manner
 disposed of any property or any part thereof with an intent
 thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the pro-
 visions of an act of Congress entitled an act to provide for
 certain Persons engaged in the Land and Naval service
 of the United States in the Revolutionary war passed the
 15th day of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any
 person or persons in trust for me any property securities con-
 tracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other
 than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed and
 by me subscribed
