the year eighteen hundred and two the year of my  
fathers death when I was appointed Administrator  
on the estate of my father the said Henry Lloyd and  
then took into my possession all of his Records papers  
which I have retained in my possession ever since  
together with the Record of marriages as above stated  
which I this day place into the <sup>hands</sup> of Bird B. Chapman  
of Elyria Sorain County in the State of Ohio I further  
doth depose and say that the above is a true copy  
of the said Record with the exception of the date  
which is corrected on the Record in fair legible fig-  
ures January 4. 1775 I have been a resident of the aforesaid  
Town of Walker and County of Huntington since  
the year seventeen hundred and ninety four up  
to this day and from my earliest recollection I  
was acquainted with the aforesaid John Shearer and  
his wife Temperance until their removal into  
the State of Ohio and the said John Shearer was  
a Soldier in the Revolution I am now acquainted  
with John Shearer who is a resident of the aforesaid  
County of Huntington and is a son of the aforesaid
