in and for said County Before the Honourable Charles Huston
Esquire & David Stewart & Joseph M Cune Esquires his associates
Judges &c (being a Court of Record) Personally appeared Leonard
Goops who being duly sworn deposeseth and saith & on his oath
afousaid doth declare that he Enlisted as a Soldier in the
Revolutionary War for the space of three years or during the
War in a Company Commanded by Captain Hebrich in the
Regiment called Colonel Plumpton's Regiment Com-
manded by Colonel Plumpton of the Pennsylvania
Line as set forth in his original Declaration the date of
which he doth not now precisely recollect but believes
it was some time in June 1818 which declaration was
forwarded to the war Department & on which a pension
Certificate was issued to the said Leonard Goops dated
the 28th day of December 1818 Signed J C Calhoun Secretary
of the War which Certificate is numbered 5096 and is
in possession of declarant who in pursuance of the act
of Congress on the 20th May 1820 makes the following dec-
laration on oath (To wit) I Leonard Goops do swear
that I was a Resident Citizen of the United States on
the 18th day of March 1818 & that I have not since that
time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of my property
or any part thereof with an intent thereby to diminish
it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress
Entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the
Land and Naval Service of the United States in the Revolutionary
War passed on the 18th day of March 1818 & that I have not
nor has any Person or Persons in trust for me any property or Secu-
rities Contract or debts due me nor have I any Income other
than which is contained in the Schedule hereunto
annexed & by me subscribed the said declarant also states that he
is 64 years of age on the 21st day of July last that he is a
Shoemaker by trade but owing to his advanced age is unable
to obtain a livelihood thereby for himself
